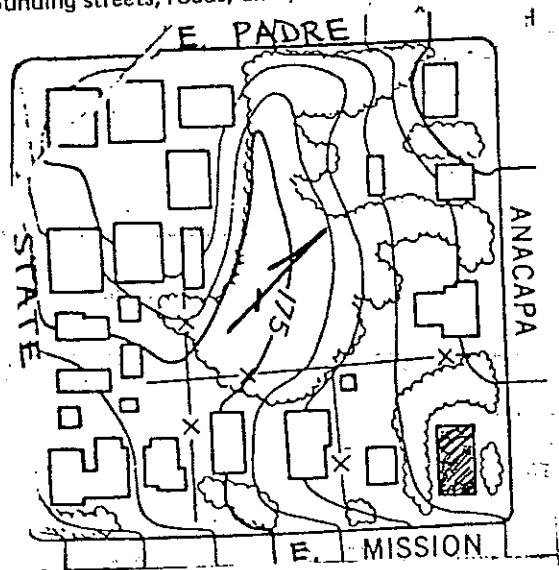
19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)
- This handsome Craftsman was built in 1909 by Pound and Poole, a construction firm very active between 1910-1930. The large, projecting gabled dormer in the center, nicely balanced by the two large fixed and double-hung window arrangements on either side of the front entrance give this house much of its visual appeal. The original owner was J. Foster Flagg, occupation unknown, and his widow, Florence, continued to live here from 1928-1940. Since then, there have been several owners and/or residents, but the house has been well maintained and the original design unchanged.

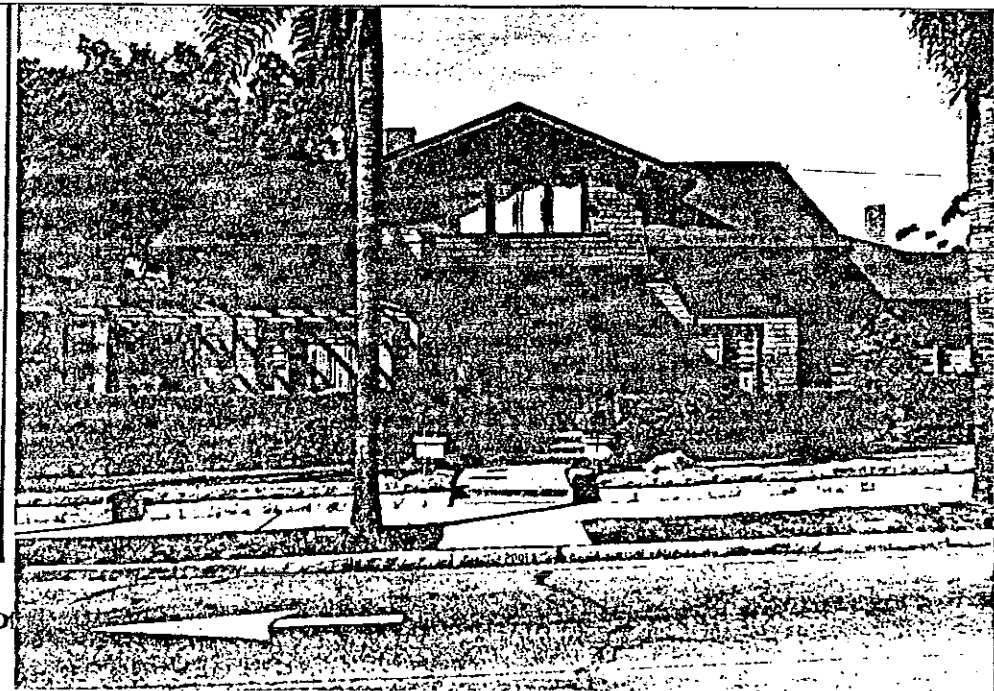

DESCRIPTION

- 7b. Briefly describe the present *physical description* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

This two-story Craftsman style house has a medium pitched gable roof that has wide overhangs supported by lookout beams and is ornamented with sculpted bargeboards at all the gable ends. There are triple support columns at the recessed entryway. An arbor to the right of the entry has intricately shaped purlin ends. The lawn is well landscaped, and a two-course sandstone retaining wall separates the lawn from the sidewalk. An unrelated carport sits on the side to the rear of the house.
